WHEREAS, Section 1605(i)(2) of the land bank act requires the hiring or firing of any employee of the land bank to be approved by a majority of the total membership of the board of directors; and

WHEREAS, Section 1605(i)(2) of the land bank act further provides that the function of hiring or firing of any employee of the land bank may, by majority vote of the total membership of the board of directors, be delegated to a specified officer or committee of the land bank, under such terms and conditions, and to the extent, that the board may specify; and

WHEREAS, the board of directors desires to delegate the authority to hire and fire employees of the land bank to the Executive Director in accordance with Section 1605(i)(2) of the land bank act.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GREATER SYRACUSE PROPERTY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION AS FOLLOWS:** 

<u>Section 1.</u> The recitals above are hereby incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set forth herein.

<u>Section 2.</u> The Executive Director of the GSPDC is hereby authorized, directed and empowered to hire and fire employees of the land bank.

<u>Section 3.</u> The Executive Director shall exercise the authority delegated herein in compliance with all federal, state and local laws applicable to matters of employment and in accordance with all policies of the land bank, as such polices may be amended from time to time.

<u>Section 4.</u> The authority delegated herein to the Executive Director to hire employees of the land bank is subject to the land bank's approved budget for such expenditures.

<u>Section 5.</u> This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
